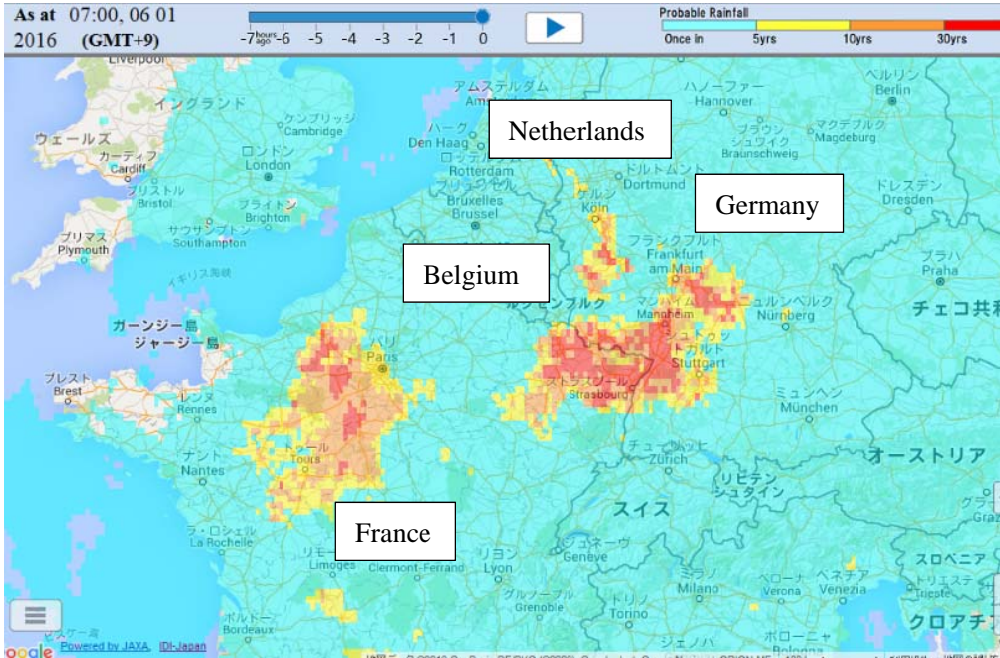

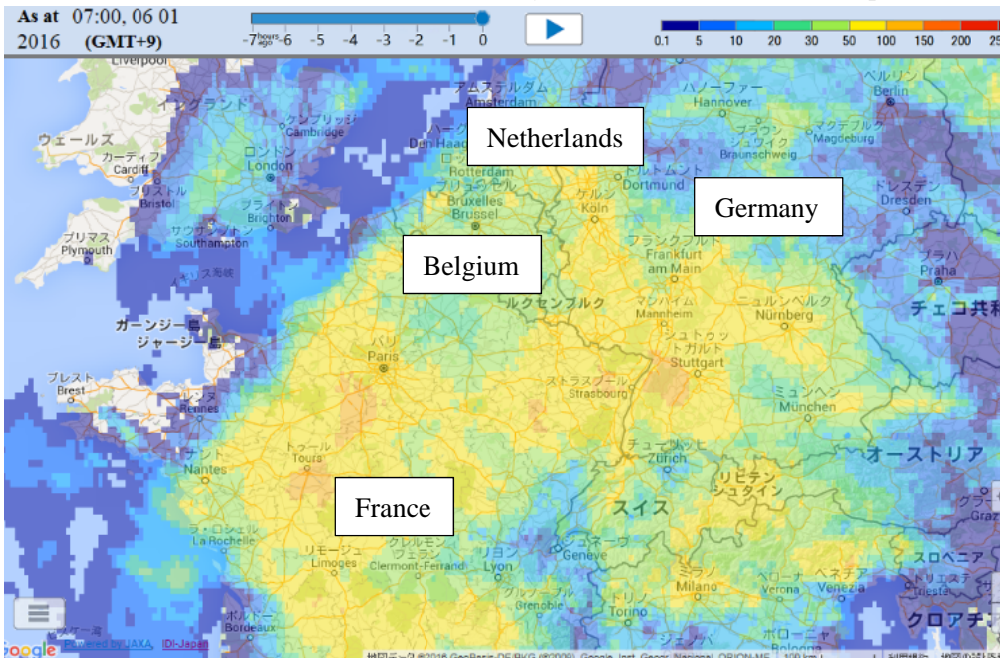

72 Hours Probable Rainfall (7:00am, May 29 – 7:00am, June 1 JST (Japan Standard Time))

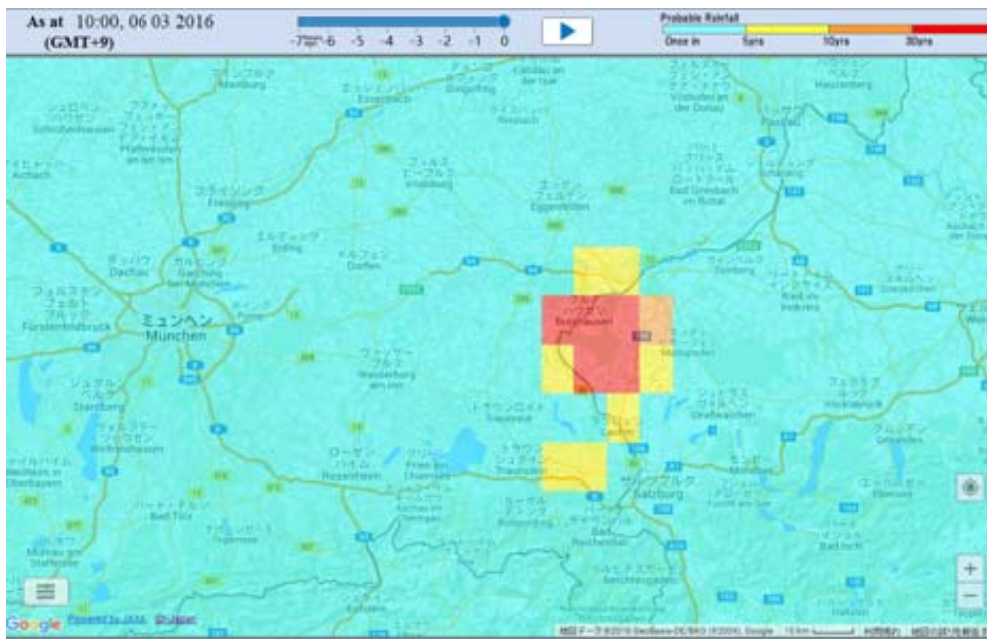


72 Hours Accumulated Rainfall (7:00am, May 29 – 7:00am, June 1 JST (Japan Standard Time))

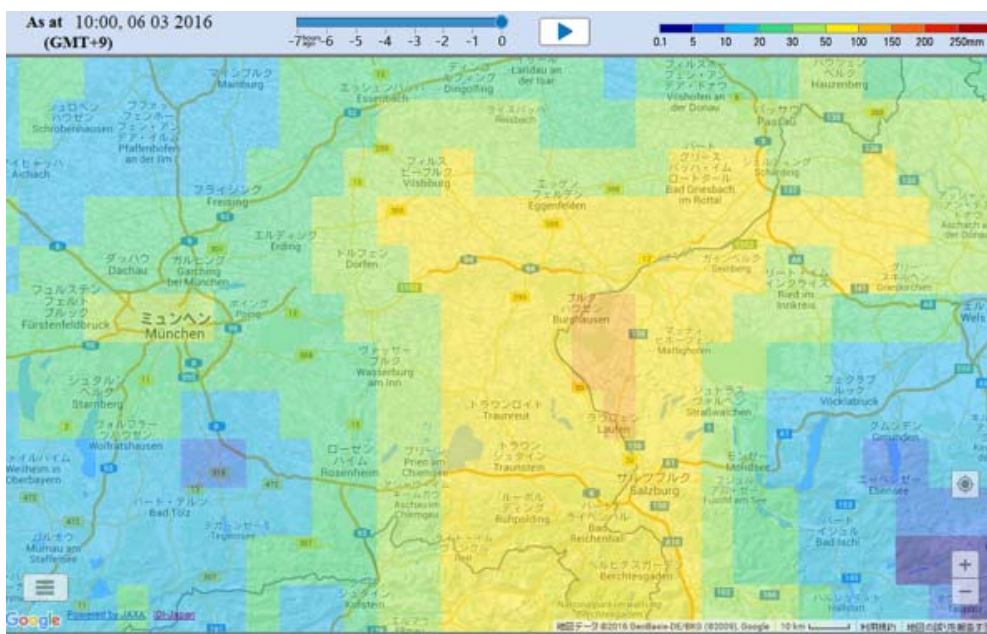

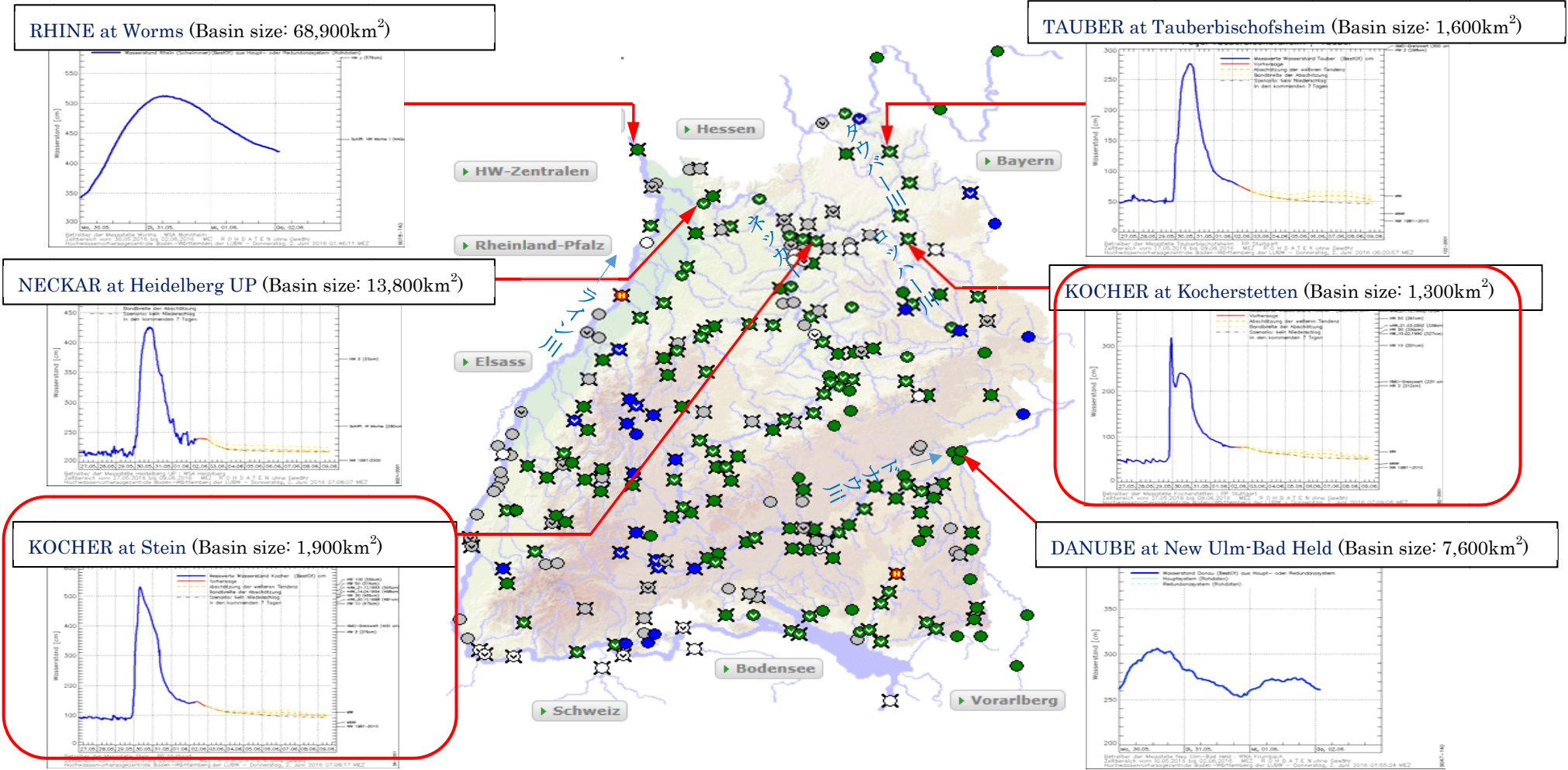
72 Hours Probable Rainfall (10:00am, May 31 – 10:00am, June 3 JST (Japan Standard Time))

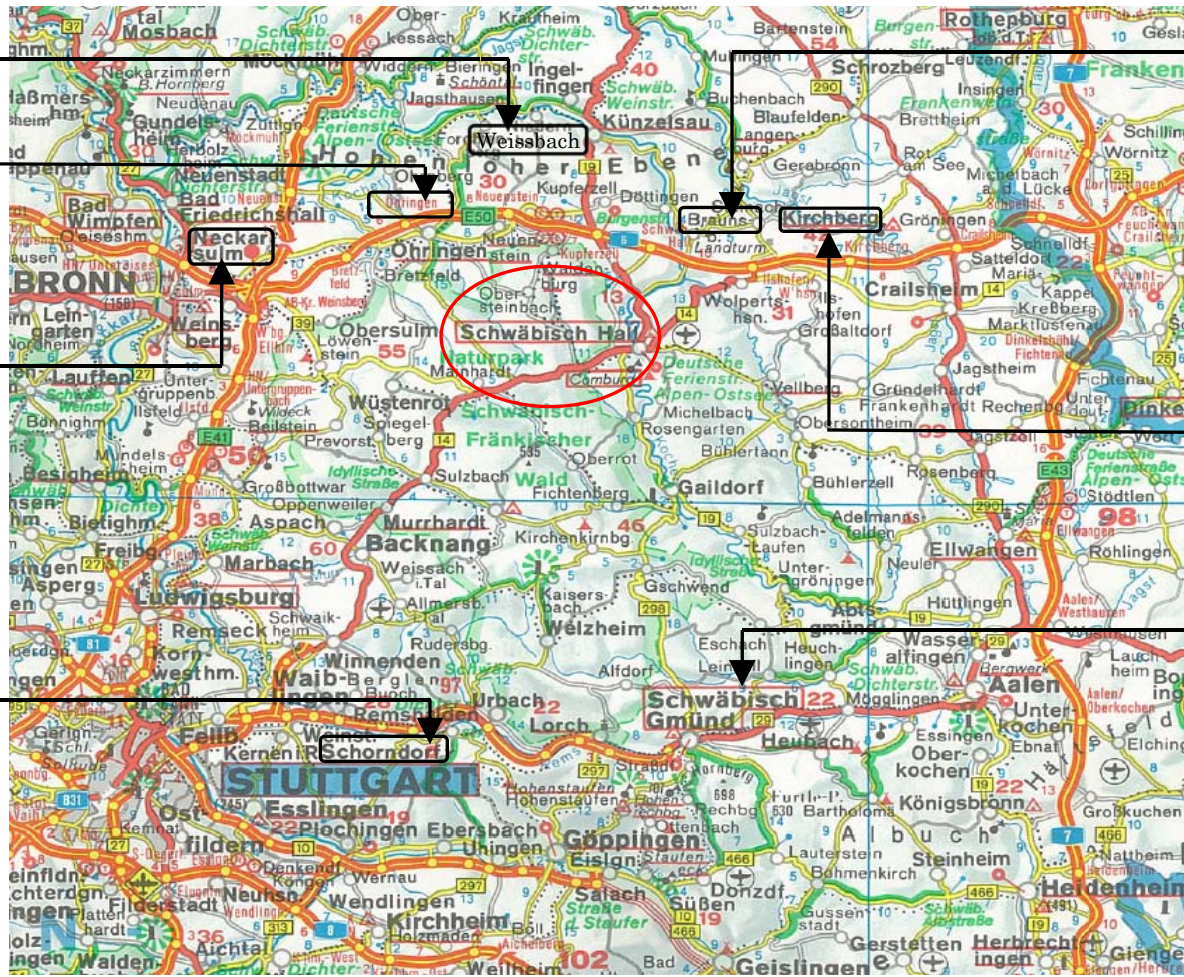
Weissbach
