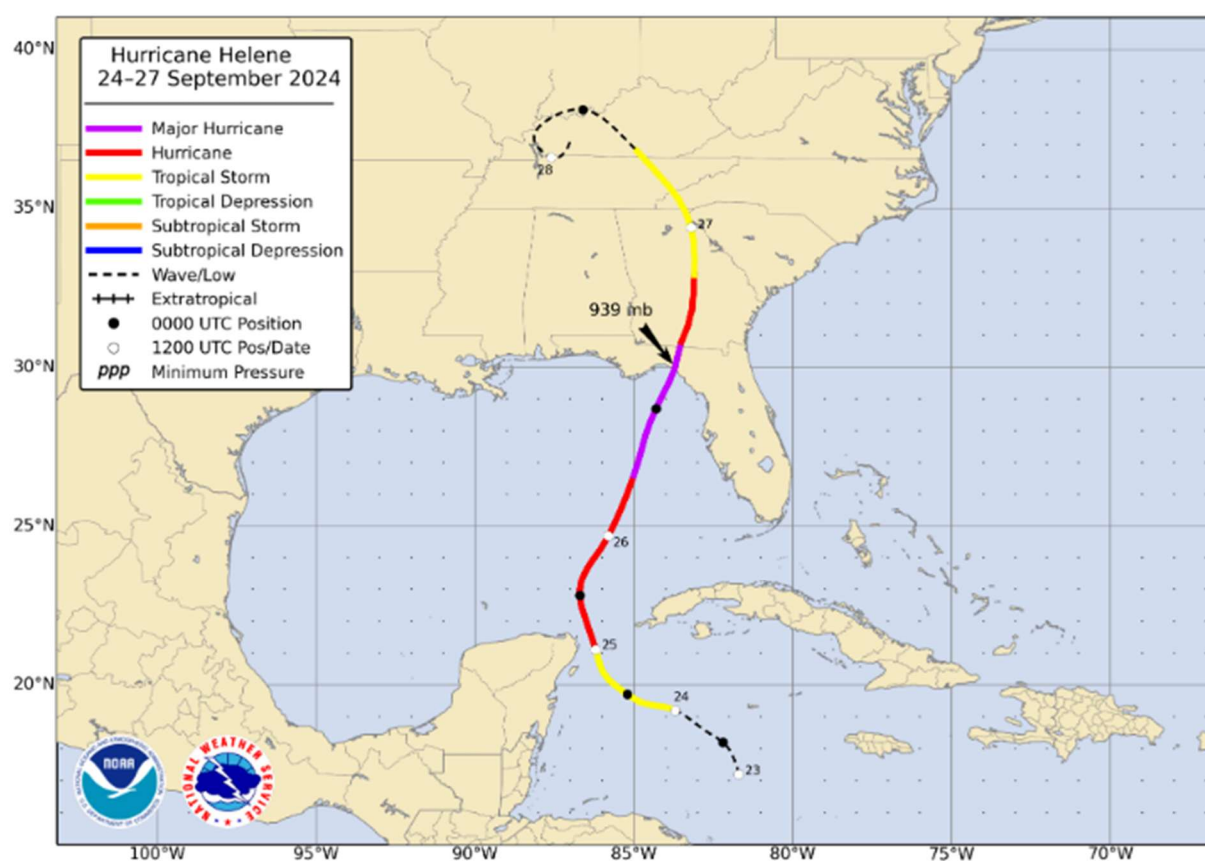

Outline	Hurricane HELENE, a large Category 4 hurricane, made landfall in Florida, causing storm surge flooding on the west coast of Florida. Although it weakened in strength, it brought heavy rain to the Appalachian Mountains, causing rivers with water sources in the mountains to overflow, resulting in severe flooding in western North Carolina and surrounding areas.
