#### India (Northeast)

# China (Sichuan) (Jun)

A massive landslide swallowed Xinmo Village in Mao County after days of heavy rain. Death toll: 10. Missing: 73.

#### USA (Midwest and South) (Apr)

Severe storms slammed the South and the Midwest with deadly flooding, tornadoes and even snow. Death toll: 13.

#### Colombia (Mar)

A devastating mudslide occurred in the southwest city of Mocoa after heavy rains caused rivers to overflow.

#### Death toll: 336.
